

Career & Technical Math Student Commitment Form

One hour Math credit will be awarded to those students who complete a six-hour CTE (Career & Technical Education) program. A value of .25 credit will be awarded each semester.

Program procedures and instructions

1. Students attend informational meeting to learn process
2. Students interested in working toward EC sign commitment form
3. Student file set in place to accommodate graded objectives
4. Mr. Hall, Math Instructor, reviews the student's performance and level of acceptability to monitor if he or she is ready to advance through the program. If mastery of subject is not obtained, Mr. Hall will identify the objective to be accomplished and place it in the CCC teacher's mailbox with a note explaining what concept needs to be mastered.
5. CCC teacher assists students with preparation and quality of assignments (many of the assignments will be incorporated into the CTE curriculum)
6. A total of 16 objectives must be met at a 70% mastery rate for credit to be awarded. Four (4) objectives must be successfully completed each semester to receive .25 credit. Failure to complete the semester objectives may result in the student being removed from the embedded credit program.
7. CCC teachers and students are responsible for meeting completion timelines
8. The ultimate decision for completing quality work on EC objectives and meeting timelines lies with the students (credit will only be awarded if objectives are completed according to the set criteria)
9. First semester objectives are to be completed by **December 12, 2008**. Second semester objectives to be completed by **April 3, 2009**.

This program is voluntary. A student should not solely rely on this credit to meet graduation requirements. Please consult your High School Guidance Counselor to determine your graduation status. (Credit is awarded by your High School.)

Please enroll me in the Embedded Credit program. I understand it is my responsibility to complete all the necessary criteria accurately in order to receive the credit.
